

INSTRUCTIONS FOR MAIL-IN VOTE 2021 - Local 20378, CMHC Granville Island

All members in good standing of Local 20378, CMHC Granville Island are eligible to receive and use a MAIL-IN BALLOT to cast their vote for ratification. If you are a RAND MEMBER, a membership application card will be in your kit for you to complete.

Only those members who are in good standing and who have registered and attended the mandatory information session by WEBINAR / TELECONFERENCE will have their vote (white ballot) counted towards ratification.

RAND members - you will be provided 2 ballots- one white and one orange. If you complete a membership card, you can vote in the ratification vote using the **white ballot**. Those who do not sign a membership card can complete the strike authorization ballot (**orange ballot**) instead.

Please complete your mail-in ballot as follows:

1. Clearly mark either the *"I am in favour of the agreement"* box or the *"I am not in favour of the agreement and therefore am prepared to take strike action"* box on your ballot. For RAND members who do not sign a membership card, clearly mark *"I am in favour of strike action up to and including a general strike"* box or the *"I am not in favour of strike action"* box on the orange ballot.
2. If you wish to make comments to explain your decision, you may do so on the back of the ballot.
3. Place your completed ballot in the **smaller (brown) envelope** and seal the envelope.
4. Your name, complete home address and PSAC ID will be pre-printed and affixed to a **larger (white) pre-addressed and pre-paid envelope**. If you have any questions, please contact the Vancouver Regional Office at 1-800-663-1655.

THIS INFORMATION MUST BE PROVIDED IN FULL IN ORDER TO VALIDATE YOUR ELIGIBILITY TO VOTE.

5. Place the small brown envelope into the larger white envelope and then into a Canada Post Mailbox. If you are a RAND Member, be sure to complete and include your membership application card in the larger white envelope as well.
6. Mail your ballot. The deadline for receipt of your ballot by the PSAC Regional Office is the **close of business, September 3, 2021. Ballots received after this deadline will not be included in the final count.**

FYI – If your ballot is received on time by the Regional Office:

- All envelopes received from the members are validated.
- If valid, the outer envelope is removed and the unmarked smaller (brown) ballot envelope is added to the Local's ballot box for counting on **September 3, 2021**.
