Monique - how many people attending the conference from this group - Priscilla this has be been announced yet.

Karen Sutton there are 75 spots, confirmation will be sent in a few days resolutions deadline is October 21

Priscilla - we had some resolutions from before, mentoring as part of our resolutions, encourage more women to be more engaged and participate.

any suggestions on resolutions - Lea-what are key issues that are keeping women back from getting involved in the union? this would help us to formulate a resolutions Priscilla - ladies are shy and don't know how to engage, they need more support them, what resolutions can we put forward to support them? Lea - what if PSAC implement a buddy system, like a hybrid of mentoring and sister check in. Maybe this is not a resolution and maybe at AGM can put together to introduce ourselves to new members, Monique - missing members as lists are not updated

Monica - address Lea's idea - in the welcome package, a brochure is included to advise of the various committees, Monica clarified "pink tax" - the movement to remove the tax on feminine products

Priscilla asked if there are any suggestions for resolutions to put forward-Nielene Ruby-interested where the committee, union women's voices - what's the stand on prostitution and sex work. lack of voice for women in prostitution, their voice isn't heard. we have people who believe that prostitution is sex work. priscilla does not have any info on this, Zita didn't know, asked Monica if PSAC is lobbying for this issue, now the

question would be what is PSAC stand on this issue? Monica will bring up the question on behalf of the committee and provide feedback to the members.

Ruby- can this resolution be crafted through the human rights committee? Monica responded yes

Jennifer - with virtual workplace, there are no union boards anymore...employer is supposed to provide this to the workers. we have a right to a virtual union board, should be employer provided. can a resolution be drafted that it becomes a bargaining demand, so it can be discussed with the employer. technically the employer needs to provide a union board as now the work is virtual, where are they supposed to get their union information from.

Lea - can help with Jennifer with this

Monique - there needs to be a union board

Zita - there is a union board to put stuff up. should be in the contract - virtual or live Priscilla - should this resolution be for the women's conference or the regional conference asking Monica - Monica advised if for the women's conference then the resolution would have to be created today. Priscilla asking Lea what her thought are so we can formulate this for the next conference. Lea - can work on resolution with Jenn, Priscilla will put forward this resolution for the BC Regional Conference. Reena would like to be part of the resolution writing with the other members

Zita - December 6th - women that were killed in Polytechnique university in Quebec, area council will be holding a vigil in holland park, west fraser area council, we can participate together. perhaps we can assist with money and get volunteers to come out for December 6th.

Jennifer - will we be asking for donations or money to go to local shelters? Nielene clarified we can participate and donate.

Zita would like to make a motion to use the \$300 to support the December 6th vigil, Jennifer seconded motion

Monique - agree with the money part, unable to participate, have a way where members can donate, email transfer perhaps?

Zita - great idea, people may feel that they want to donate to a shelter in their area so maybe leave it with the people as to where they want to donate. Lea will make a list of various shelters. Nielene suggested to advise everyone to donate to a shelter of their choice in their area.

Jennifer - there have been collection of items and taken to a place close to the vigil. so people who are actually attending feel like they brought something. perhaps we can work on a list that are within our area that we can include in callout, and lastly some of the events that have been sponsored by labour council there was a virtual component would allow people who can't attend can be then be part of it. Zita advised that Victoria did virtual last year however they are not this year. Monica advised that vigils will be in person.

Priscilla - do we all agree on motions - all good motion has passed donation request - Zita - labour

Zita motion to donate \$150 to BC fed Christmas dinner on December 23rd. Lea seconded - priscilla said motion carried
