Adoption of tentative agenda – Moved by Laurie, Seconded by Corinne, Carried

Treasurer Report – Corinne reviewed, broke down the amount. Monique suggested to put another section in the October 11 minutes as there was not a quorum but can be included in appendix

Accept financial report? – moved by Corrine, Seconded by Lauri, Carried

Lauri – what are the kinds of things this committee uses the funds for? How do we accumulate funds?
