### PSAC Staff Advisor update

Nielene spoke about the Work Force Adjustment training courses for Treasury Board & Parks local officers and members. Lunch and learn opportunities are available for CRA and CFIA.

Convention Procedures is an educational course now available to register online the PSAC BC website.

There is also a Treasury Board Mobilization summit call-out available to register online.

The PA Group town hall just passed and each bargaining unit will have their own town hall.

It is the 10-year anniversary of Phoenix, and PSAC is providing postcards for members to mail out to their Member of Parliament to highlight that this is an ongoing issue that has not been fully addressed.

### Roundtable

Colin confirmed with the EVFAC President, that the MHRC financial support in the amount of \$1100 for Pumpkin Fest, as per this committee's July 10 2025 minutes, is no longer required.
